



MAIOLICA DRUG JAR

(Irish, dress or cloak fastener)




ARCHER-BUTLER LUCK STONE

(Irish\English, ornamented bronze bowls)




BRONZE AGE SHIELD

(Irish, used in combat)




DISH WITH CROWNED WOMAN DESIGN
