





AXEHEAD Item Code HCA 638

An iron axehead with a widely splayed cutting edge.




BONE COMB Item Code HCA 592

A bone comb with a single edge. It is decorated on both faces with criss-cross lines, parallel lines and circles.




DRINKING-HORN Item Code HCM 217

A drinking-horn with metal gilt mounts. The horn rests on claw feet. The rim of the horn is incised with lettering.




RINGED PIN Item Code HCA 519

A silver pin with a twisted ring and ornate polyhedral pin head with circular depressions which once had settings.




NECK-RING Item Code HCA 452

A silver neck ring made up of woven strands and ending with knobbed terminals.




METHER OR DRINKING VESSEL Item Code HCM 224

A mether/ meadair, a drinking cup, in wood. It is four-sided with three angular handles, elongated at the end, so they end parallel to the base.



BROOCH Item Code HCA 504

A bronze brooch of the spectacle type. It consists of thin strips of bronze coiled into two circular shapes with the strips twisted into a figure-of-eight between the circles. It has a bronze pin and two bronze loops at the back. Early Hallstatt style.



SWORD Item Code HCA 637

An iron sword with a short blade and a T-shape hilt.
